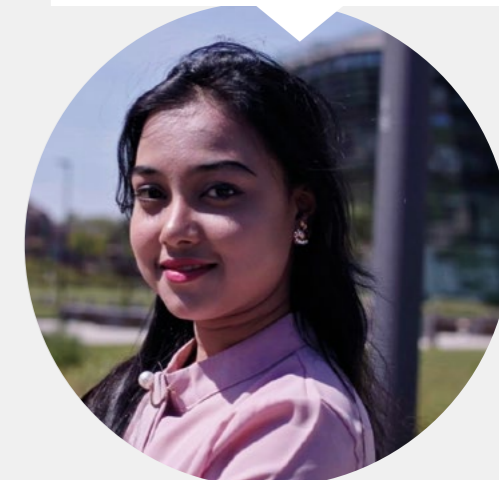

## International Incorporated Bachelors (IIB)

The IIB allows you to study a foundation year in a wide range of academic subjects across our University partnerships. The course has been designed to strengthen your academic English abilities and introduce you to fundamental concepts required in your chosen subject area. ## International Incorporated Masters (IIM)

The IIM is designed for those students who do not qualify for direct entry to a postgraduate degree. This could be because of the grades achieved in your undergraduate degree; current qualifications are not equivalent to an undergraduate degree or if you want to improve your academic and English language skills.

**International Year Zero / Foundation Diploma (IYZ / IFD)**

**DMUIC / BUIC / UGIC / UBIC / OIPC / ICD\***

**• Direct entry into Year 1 • 4 years total study**

The IYZ provides one year of preparation for undergraduate degree study. Once students have completed this year, they will continue to the first year of their chosen degree directly with the University.

\*Please note ICD's IYZ can also be found under the name International Stage One (IS1).

**International Year One / First Year (IY1 / IFY)**

**DMUIC / BUIC / UGIC / UBIC / ICD\***

**• Direct entry into Year 2 • 3 years total study**

The IFY / IY1 equivalent to the first year of study at undergraduate level. Once students have completed this year, they will continue to the second year of their degree study directly with the University.

\*Please note ICD's IY1 can also be found under the name International Stage Two (IS2).

**International Second Year (ISY)**

**DMUIC • Direct entry into Year 3 • 2 years total study**

The ISY / IY1 equivalent to the first year of study at undergraduate level. Once students have completed this year, they will continue to the second year of their degree study directly with the University.

**International Year One Programme**

**SFSU • 4 years total study**

Once you have completed International Year One and matriculated into your second year at SF State, you can begin to choose from a broad range of majors for your final degree.

**Mercy College International Undergraduate Programme**

**MERCY COLLEGE • 4 years total study**

Once you have completed Mercy College International Undergraduate Programme and matriculated into your second year at Mercy College, you can begin to choose from a broad range of majors for your final degree.

**Pre-Top Up in Business (PTU 1 term or 2 term)**

**DMUIC • Direct entry into final year of study**

**• 1+ total study**

The PTU in Business is a top-up preparation course of 10 weeks (1 Term) or 20 weeks (2 Term) duration that provides international students a route to complete an undergraduate degree at DMU.

**International Incorporated Masters (IIM 1 term or 2 term) / Graduate**

**All Colleges • Direct entry into master's degree**

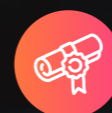
**• 1+ years total study**

The IIM provides students with the advanced study skills and academic English support required for master's level study. This course can be studied over a number of terms depending on a student's academic qualifications and English language level, options vary from university to university.

**Pre-Sessional English**

These courses provide you with an initial period of intensive English language training and assessments. This academic English support is delivered over 6 or 12 weeks. You will need to successfully complete this before you can continue onto your chosen pathway. The number of terms you complete will depend on your current English level.

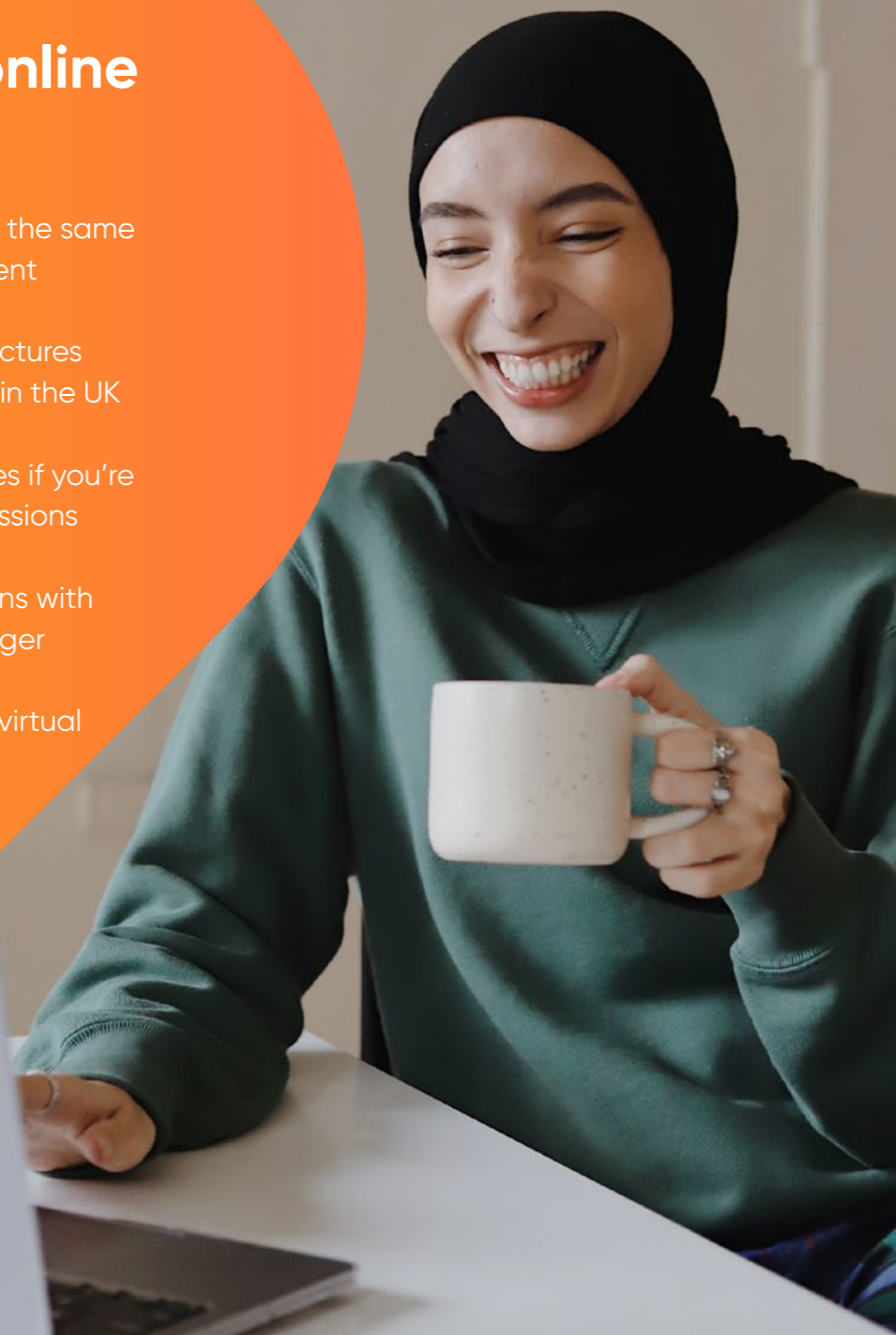

### Pre-Sessional English (Various Dates)

The Online Pre-Sessional Course (OPSE) is a 6- or 12-week programme that provides you with an initial period of intensive English language training and assessments – adapted for online learning. Upon successful completion of the course, you will progress onto your designated International College.

### English Testing

If you don't have proof of English, such as an IELTS you can take the Oxford International English Test, once completed you can expect to receive your results within 3 working days.

## Online studying FAQ's

### Where and when do classes take place?

Some live classes will take place online through each college's online learning platform. Learning materials may be available on the same online platform or separately.

### Can I message other students/Tutors/Lecturers directly?

Yes. Upon enrolment you will be giving contact details for your tutors and will be able to arrange a time to meet with them virtually. This is the same process as if you were studying in the college.

### What if I cannot attend a lesson because I am abroad and there is a significant time difference?

All online live classes will be recorded and available to students to access from their Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) after the class has happened. However most online live classes have been timetabled to avoid unsociable hours in different time zones where possible. It won't be possible to achieve this for every region which is why you will also have access to the recordings.

### How will work be marked and assessed?

All colleges have adapted their assessment methods for online learning, and these have been rigorously reviewed and agreed by each University partner. The methods will vary college to college.

### How can I access the resources I need?

All online materials and learning resources will be available through your VLE account. University resources will also be available to you on this platform such as e-books and online services.

### What if I have any questions?

Each college has an Administration manager and support team who are available through different channels such as Virtual Receptions. They will be there to help and support you as they would if you were on campus.

## What will happen after an application has been submitted?

Below is a step-by-step guide.

### STAGE 2: Check qualifications
